## A La Turca

With its lack of signboard outside the premises, visitors often miss A La Turca, a real treasure trove of Ottoman and Anatolian antiques. Opening in 1998 in the neighbourhood of Çukurcuma, owner Erkal Aksoy converted the fourstorey house into a showroom to trade antique carpets and kilims, as well as paintings, ceramics, manuscripts and other decorative objects. Aksoy was one of the pioneers of the changing face of Çukurcuma, and it is thanks to him that the once-derelict street is now home to the city's best art galleries and design shops. Browsing among A La Turca's treasures can feel like visiting the private home of a serious collector, rather than a shop. Aksoy considers anyone who passes through the door of his magnificent showroom as an honoured guest, and welcomes shoppers with home-made cherry liqueur and butter cookies. If you wish to be on the receiving end of Aksoy's hospitality, be sure to arrange an appointment before ringing the bell.
